Tier 1A - Standards-based Instructional Practices for Foreign Language and ELL Teachers

For teachers of all languages and ELL, this workshop focuses on standards-based instructional practices that develop students' proficiency. Presenters will demonstrate a wide variety of strategies that really work to keep today's students actively engaged and in the target language. Tier 1B - Using Stories to Enhance Standards-based Foreign Language and ELL Instruction

For teachers of all languages, this workshop presents highly motivational and engaging storytelling strategies to develop language proficiency. Participants will learn easy steps to accelerate proficiency through a variety of inputs, reading, and stories. It emphasizes standards-based approaches that

Tier 2 – Standards-based Instructional Practices for Teachers of Advanced Spanish Classes

For teachers of Spanish 4, AP Language, and Spanish for Spanish Speakers. Teachers will be shown how to implement an engaging and motivating thematic unit, **Los derechos humanos (Human Rights)** designed to ensure student success on the AP Spanish Language Exam. The presentation will address all areas included in the new examination: aural/oral skills, reading comprehension, grammar, and composition. Participants will receive all materials presented as well as suggestions for implementation. (Observation Day TBA) College of Education, Room 106
