Training can be as much as 30-40 hours. It can have various configurations.

1. Weekly department collaboration/common-planning meetings
2. A single half day training or a series of half day trainings
3. A full day training or a series (weekly, monthly) of full day trainings.
4. A full week of training
5. This can be done on a school level or at the district level.
6. Each of the above can be accompanied by classroom (individual) coaching.
